Basic Facts

- **Monumentenwacht**
The Dutch Monumentenwacht was founded in 1973. The organisation's key objective is to prevent the decay of the cultural fabric through the technical inspection of cultural heritage objects and the implementation of preventive measures.
- Every year, more than 24,000 listed buildings in the Netherlands are inspected by professionals of the Monumentenwacht. For each inspection a detailed report is issued on the basis of which future maintenance of the historic building by the owner can be facilitated. During these inspections, small-scale repair work might also be carried out by inspectors. Larger-scale maintenance however, is only carried out by building contractors.
- Monumentenwacht has since developed into the largest organisation of its kind in the Netherlands. A great deal of international interest has been shown in the concept over the last years. In June 2004 Monumentenwacht received the European Nostra / European Union Award for cultural heritage.
