22 full professors, 28 associate professors


- theoretical and experimental mechanics of materials, constructions and fluids
- computational methods in mechanics, acousto-electronics and application of ultrasounds in medicine,
- continuum physics, polymer physics, electromagnetic effects,
- applied information science, mechatronics and robotics,
- engineering and energy-saving pro-ecology oriented building.

The Institute runs PhD studies within the framework of which scientists from Poland and abroad obtained **over 600 PhD** degrees. **Over 180 postdoctoral (DSc)** programmes have been completed.


CH relevant research is done in Smart Technology Centre and includes mainly Structural Health Monitoring, Testing of Materials and development of Diagnostic Tools & Methods.


