The Technion - Israel Institute of Technology - is Israel's primary technological university and the largest centre of applied research. It is ranked among the leading scientific universities in the world. In 2004, two of its scientists, working in the field of Chemistry, were the first in Israel to win the Nobel Prize. The Technion comprises 18 faculties, 40 research centres, 11 research institutes and 10 Centres of Excellence. At present there are approximately 12,500 undergraduate and postgraduate students, with over 650 faculty members and 58 spin-off companies.
